

August \$ 21,074 \$ 25,700 (\$ 4,626) YTD 2022 \$194,903 \$205,600 (\$10,697)


Total revenue for the first 8 months of 2022 (including other income in addition to offerings) and total expenses are shown below.


Total Revenue through August \$208,822 Total Expenses through August \$213,014 Expenses in excess of Revenues (\$4,193)


