

ITEMS NEEDED FOR OUR CUBAN FRIENDS

Clothes and shoes: Shoes (sizes #38 - #43 – US sizes 7 – 12), underpants (men's and women's), Stockings, bras for adults (sizes M, L, XL). NOTE: We want these things for the elderly folks of our breakfast project. Also, the shoes don't have to be new. I don't want you to spend money but perhaps you have shoes from yourselves that you no longer use or maybe some could be donated. Important: at least 2 rechargeable lamps (for power failures), 2 microphones, 3 used computers batteries (AA, AAA) Sewing Supplies: fabrics, thread (all colors), whatever you can bring sewing needles Christmas: ornaments for Christmas tree in sanctuary (We already have lights). (We would like to set up a nativity scene in the church for Christmas. Do you think that will be very expensive?) Young people: flash drives. Please have items to church no later than November 1.


