



## Cuba Update

#### ITEMS NEEDED FOR OUR CUBAN FRIENDS

Clothes and shoes: Shoes (sizes #38 - #43 – US sizes 7 – 12), under-pants (men's and women's), Stockings, bras for adults (sizes M, L, XL).

NOTE: We want these things for the elderly folks of our breakfast project. Also, the shoes don't have to be new. I don't want you to spend money but perhaps you have shoes from yourselves that you no longer use or maybe some could be donated. Important: at least 2 rechargeable lamps (for power failures), 2 microphones, 3 used computers batteries (AA, AAA) Sewing Supplies: fabrics, thread (all colors), whatever you can bring sewing needles Christmas: ornaments for Christmas tree in sanctuary (We already have lights). (We would like to set up a nativity scene in the church for Christmas. Do you think that will be very expensive?) Young people: flash drives. Please have items to church no later than November 1.



## SOPC Updates

### ReShape Update

#### Worship Ministry

- a. We are continuing to regularly include a wider diversity of music both in congregational songs and in music performed. This diversity includes an emphasis on incorporating contemporary selections regularly in worship.
- b. Rally Day worship and our post worship gathering included Liberty Church musicians and their music, which is all in contemporary form and instrumentation.
- c. Outreach to bring in guest musicians and musical groups has been constrained by three things; i. COVID, II. Lack of budget funding, III. Lack of interest on the part of groups we have reached out to.
- d. We continue to be significantly challenged and limited by streaming/licensing restrictions on the music we can use in worship.


