

ITEMS NEEDED FOR OUR CUBAN FRIENDS

Clothes and shoes: Shoes (sizes #38 - #43 - US sizes 7 - 12), underpants (men's and women's), Stockings, bras for adults (sizes M, L, XL). NOTE: We want these things for the elderly folks of our breakfast project. Also, the shoes don't have to be new. I don't want you to spend money but perhaps you have shoes from yourselves that you no longer use or maybe some could be donated. Important: at least 2 rechargeable lamps (for power failures), 2 microphones, 3 used computers batteries (AA, AAA) Sewing Supplies: fabrics, thread (all colors), whatever you can bring sewing needles Christmas: ornaments for Christmas tree in sanctuary (We already have lights). (We would like to set up a nativity scene in the church for Christmas. Do you think that will be very expensive?) Young people: flash drives. Please have items to church no later than Tuesday, November 1.

Community Updates - MORE Justice

Below is all of the information that you and your Team needs for moving into the Research to Action Process!

Wow! Thank you to all who attended our Community Problems Assembly on Monday! We were grateful to have over 240 people in attendance at Shandon Presbyterian, as well as those joining us virtually from the livestream! After a resounding number of votes, Food Insecurity was chosen as our problem area that we will focus on during this justice cycle! We are excited to begin the process of addressing this issue that is impacting our community as we continue our ongoing work with Affordable Housing and Gun Violence.

Research Kick-Off: Research Kick-Off is scheduled for Thursday, November 3rd at 6:30. You can sign up here!

Monthly Newsletter: If you would like to be added to our monthly newsletter for important updates, you and/or your Network Members can sign up here.

T-Shirts: We are excited to have MORE Justice T-shirts in the works! We are currently taking orders, and if you and any of your Network Members are interested in purchasing you can follow the link to our T-shirt Order Form here.

Affordable Housing Action Step: We need a consistent and strong MORE Justice presence at Richland County Council meetings. Please sign-up and invite your Network Members to sign-up. Please sign-up here.

Gun Violence Action Step: Email the Mayor to request a meeting so that we can partner to address this serious problem. Since August 30th, we have attempted to contact Mayor Rickenmann five times, and, after responding twice that none of the several dates we offered worked for him and providing no new dates, he had not responded since. <a href="UPDATE: After receiving emails from Network Members post-CPA, Mayor Rickenmann responded via email to one of our clergy and left a voicemail asking us to call his office to schedule a meeting. This means that our action step has been effective as we received a response!

Below is the template email from the CPA agenda. Until we hear back and have a meeting scheduled, we still ask that Network Members email Mayor Rickenmann to build urgency for this serious problem. Please be sure to change wording to make the email unique and personalized for each person.
