

Welcome to Mision Cristiana Elim International Church!

If you see some new faces on our SOPC campus, it may be some members from Mision Cristiana! This small, Spanish, Christian church has been leasing space over near Dutch Square Mall, but when their lease was up, the owner sold the property.

Mision Cristiana has 35 members and 10 children, and they began renting space on our campus on June 16. Their worship service will be in our sanctuary on Sunday afternoons from 1:30 pm to 4:00 pm. During part of this time their children will meet in the nursery and the classroom next to the nursery. The church also has a Friday night service at 7:30 pm, when they will utilize the same space as they use on Sunday afternoon. In addition, there is an adult prayer meeting on Monday evenings, which will be in the Crossroads Sunday School Class. Monday evenings are also when their band will practice in the sanctuary. As with all of our renters, the needs, activities and schedule of SOPC will take priority through the term of the lease.




